Yiyî, a senior high school student, jumped off the roof of a local mulli an orthwestern China's Gansu province after her two-year search for justice ended in failure. In 2016, Li had claimed she was sexually assaulted by her high school teacher. She reported the assault to both the school and the police, and the man was later detained 30 days for the assault, a punishment both Li and her father found too light. Her father reported the case to the local procratorate, but the authorities cited both a lack of evidence and the "minor nature" of the assault for not bringing the case to prosecution. Over the two years that followed the assault, Li became depressed, her father later said.

If over Hong Kong, a colorful form of peaceful protest has been blossoming. People have been writing their thoughts, demands and encouragement onto Post-in notes, and sticking them onto walls in public spaces, creating an eye-catching and instantly recognizable mosain.

They've bloomed on walls of footbridges and pedestrian tunnels, and on the sides of government buildings and highway pilars, with some torn down as quickly as they flowered, and

others having lasted since early June. These temporary installations are called Lenon Walls, taking their name from the graffiti-covered, peacethemed wall in Prague first painted with a picture of the late musician John Lenons in 1980.

The first Hong Kong Lennon Wall appeared on the sides of the legislature in 2014, during the pro-democracy Umbrella Mowement, when major streets were occupied in the heart of the city for 79 days.
